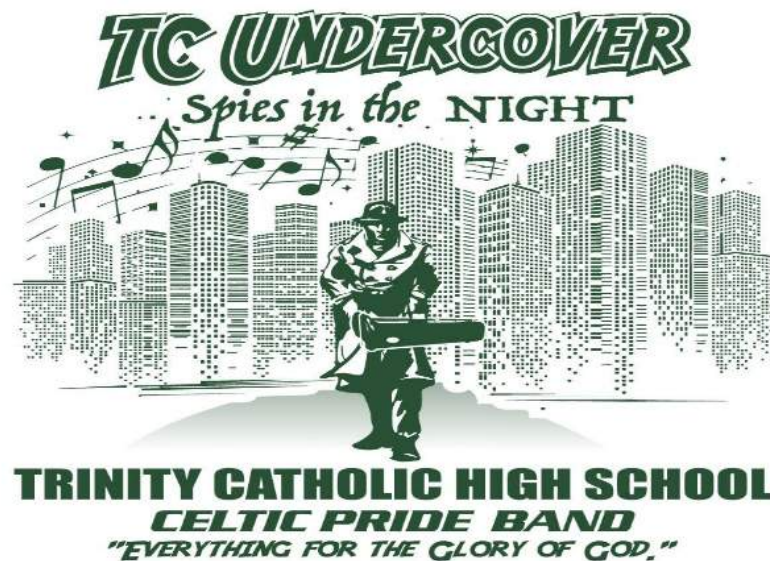

They also represented the state of Florida in the 2008 Philadelphia Thanksgiving Day Parade which was nationally syndicated on ABC-TV. Lake Weir performed in the 2006 ABC Chicago Thanksgiving Day Parade; the New York City's 2004 "Veterans Day Parade"; and also marched down 5th Avenue for the 2003 NYC Saint Patrick's Day Parade. The band represented the state of Florida in the 2018 St. Patrick's Day Parade in New Orleans and the 2019 St. Patrick's Day Parade in Chicago, Illinois! They represented the State of Florida in the 2022 St. Patrick's Day Parade in Dallas, Texas. Most recently, the band returned to New York City to march down 5th Avenue for the 2024 St. Patrick's Day.

The Marching Hurricanes 2025 field show theme is entitled "**ISSA VIBE**". The Marching Canes will begin with a song by Michael Jackson called "*Love Never Felt So Good*". Secondly, The Hurricane Drum Line will be featured on a song called "*JumpStreet*". Next, the Marching Canes will feature the Drill Team in a song by Dua Lipa called "*Don't Start Now*". Lastly, The Marching Canes will close their show with a medley of two songs by JVKE and Bruno Mars/Lady Gaga called "*Golden Hour/Die With A Smile*".
